

Schlumberger House – Gatwick

Getting here...

By Rail

Rail is the preferred method of transport to Gatwick. Frequent trains between London and South Coast. Gatwick Express and Southern Trains run from Victoria Railway Station, London. Or First Capital Connect Trains run through London via St.Pancras/Kings Cross (from N), Farringdon & London Bridge (from central London). Journey times are approximately 45 minutes. Gatwick Express trains are more expensive than scheduled services but are direct and only take 30 minutes.

On arrival at Gatwick Station go into the South Terminal, and use the walkways to exit the building to the passenger drop-off areas on the ground floor. Follow the blue pedestrian signs for "Schlumberger House/First Point". Turn right, go past the car rental offices, and then follow the footpath to the office. This is a short 15 minute walk around the Airport Ring Road South.

By Road

From the North, exit the M25 at Junction 7 (to M23) and travel south on the M23. Take the Junction 9 exit (Gatwick Airport), 2nd exit from the slip road roundabout for the M23 spur road. After approximately 0.5 miles, (1 km), at the next roundabout take the 1st exit left under the arch towards Airport South Terminal. Then immediately take the first turning left into Buckingham Gate signposted to Schlumberger House. Follow the signs for the car park. Visitors should enter by the right hand lane at the barrier using the call button to identify themselves to security.

By Air

If your flight arrives at the North Terminal take the transit shuttle to the South Terminal. Then follow the walking instructions to Schlumberger House as per the rail instructions above.
